

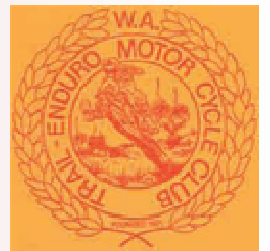
Quit **2010** **FOREST RALLY** **MOTO**

New 2 Day Rally Moto

Quit Forest Rally - Moto
Saturday 17th April &
Sunday 18th April 2010

The Western Australian Car Club in conjunction with the Western Australian Trail and Enduro Club intend running a new 2 Day RallyMoto event. The Quit Forest Rally is WA's round of the Australian Rally Championship and the QFR-Moto will run on the same gravel rally roads as the rally cars. The rally cars typically do all special stages [selectives] twice and the bikes and quads will run in the time gap between the first run and the second run of the rally cars and then a second run after the rally cars. All gravel special stages will be professionally set up and timed to Australian Rally Championship standards.

This is an extremely rare opportunity for all Moto riders to get in amongst the glamour and action of WA's premier gravel rally. All riders will be invited to do a demonstration ride in front of a large crowd at the Busselton Toyota Super Special Stage on Friday evening 16th April. This is a tarmac stage on the Busselton foreshore. Riders will also be able to display their bikes, quads and sponsor information in the pit area at the super special stage.
